CATEGORY TITLE	RANK ORDER	COMPONENTS
Discipleship		Includes Christian education, Evangelism, and Deepening Faith
Justice and Outreach		Assessment of Community Needs and Congregational Response to those Needs
Leadership		Determining Balance and Accountability between Lay Leaders and Paid Staff; Raising up Leadership skills in both.
Ministry Partnerships		How important are opportunities for Shared Ministry (Informal, Amalgamation, Cluster)? Should the Staff operate by Team Consensus or by a Top-down model?
Pastoral Care		How important is pastoral care/visitation to ministry in our current congregation.
Stewardship		How important is regular review of all aspects of Stewardship (Time, Talent, Treasury)?
Worship		Breadth and Depth of Worship including music, liturgy, preaching, children's focus.
