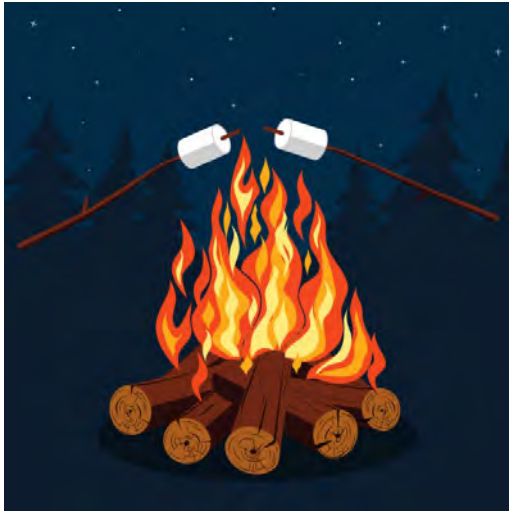
As always, we would like to thank our friends at FSA, Metropolitan, and Siloam for so graciously opening their doors to us to get this ministry up-and-running!
